Students are required to complete 120 hours of summer clerkship in the field of patient care, carried out only in hospital wards, covering 6-hour working day. Each student should at least twice during their summer clerkship perform their duty in the afternoon and evening. In order to complete the summer clerkship, the student has to demonstrate knowledge of the general principles in terms of work organization of the hospital ward and practical skills in patient care, including subcutaneous and intramuscular injections.

1. **The aim of the summer clerkship** is to acquaint a student with the full domain of activities connected with attending to the patient’s needs, routines and administrative work in the functioning of hospital wards.
2. The function of the summer clerkship supervisor responsible for carrying out of the summer clerkship program is performed by a physician authorized by the head of the unit.
3. The Unit organizing the summer clerkship / Person authorized by the Head of the Unit organizing the summer clerkship, credits the summer clerkship by placing an appropriate entry **in the student’s summer clerkship card**. The condition for completing the summer clerkship is achieving the assumed learning outcomes by the student.
